How the Need was identified.

We felt our children needed a great deal of support to deal with everything that is going on in their lives and we wanted to work towards raising their self esteem.

Chosen Criteria.

Steps taken to meet the criteria.

- Introduction of a gold book contains names of worker of the week
- The "Writer of the Week" receives a certificate and pen. This child and the worker of the week sit at a special table for lunch.
- Golden tokens for playtimes
- Certificates for attendance swimming and French.
- Two cups for progress half termly.
- A sunny bench in the playground where you can sit when you are feeling lonely
- Class and individual stars.
- Newsletter/Help line for parents.

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Who was involved in the process

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All members of teacher/support staff, governors and children.

Outcomes/Impact on pupils and the wider community.

Pupils self esteem has been continually raised with the reward system we have in place – a continued celebration of all the positive aspects of our school. Partnership between pupils/parents and school enhanced.
